APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

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- 1. Applicant must pick up the application in person and have a photo identification. A non-refundable \$25.00 processing fee is due upon the receipt of the application. Payment must be by money order or cashier's check, made payable to the: "Insulator's Joint Apprenticeship Program".
- 2. Applicant must return the completed application to the office of the committee, postmarked on or before <u>May 2, 2025</u>.
- 3. Applicant must be a minimum of eighteen (18) years of age at the time of acceptance into program.
- 4. Applicant must be physically able to perform the work of the trade.
- 5. Applicant must be a high school graduate or have a G.E.D at the time of acceptance into program.
- 6. Applicant must have a dependable form of transportation.

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- 7. Applicant must have resided within the geographical jurisdiction of the Heat and Frost Insulators and Allied Workers Local #2, for a minimum of one year immediately prior to the application date. (See below.)
- 8. Applicant will be required to take a written examination.
- 9. Applicant must pass a certified drug test, at the program's expense, before final acceptance into the program.

Applicants who qualify, based on the written examination, will be granted a personal interview.
